





### Introduction


The firm collates diversity information in accordance with the SRA (Solicitors Regulation Authority) Diversity Questionnaire.

These figures are reflected as 100% for the purpose of tables and charts.




### **Respondents per SRA role category**







### **Gender Profile**




Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?

### **Gender Profile by Role**








### **Ethnicity**








Which type of school did you attend for the most time between the ages of 11 and 16?


Did either of your parents attend university and gain a degree (eg BA/BSc or equivalent) by the time you were 18?
